**CONTENT: A two-day intensive, interactive, and practice-dominated course** designed to help professionals learn how to intervene with someone who is suicidal. In any given year, 14 million people experience suicidal thoughts--more than will experience symptoms of a heart attack. Just as "CPR" skills make physical first aid possible, training in suicide intervention helps by de-escalating a suicidal situation and getting the person at risk the help they need.

This workshop is for mental health professionals, nurses, physicians, teachers, counselors, youth workers, police and correctional staff, and clergy.



**TRAINER: Peggy Jones, MSW, LCSW, LMFT**, holds a Master of Social Work degree from Indiana University Indianapolis (IUPUI) and is licensed in Indiana as a clinical social worker and marriage and family therapist. She is the assistant director of the Behavioral Health and Family Studies Institute at IPFW (Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne) providing consultation and program development in the areas of suicide prevention, mental health response to disaster, and behavioral health topics. She has been a therapist in private practice for over 20 years. Peggy is an ASIST, safeTALK, and QPR trainer and a safeTALK instructor and has extensive training experience in public and private organizations. She has been a frequent presenter at state and national conferences.

**TRAINER: Britta Neinast, LSW** worked in the business field for years; however, with the desire to build stronger families and healthier communities, she returned to college. Britta currently holds a Masters of Social Work from Indiana University Northwest. As a licensed social worker, she works as a therapist at Family Concern Counseling in Valparaiso, Indiana providing services related to mental illness, addiction, family and adolescent struggles, suicide, self-harm behavior, and our elderly population. After losing her father to suicide, Britta also became a Certified ASIST Trainer and speaker on this difficult issue.
