Particular emphasis is placed on understanding the use and misuse of the DSM within the mental health profession. An overview of accurately using the diagnostic categories is stressed with an emphasis on treatment planning and practice strategy.

- Become familiar with the changes between the DSM-IV-TR and the expected changes for DSM-5.
- Identify the DSM disorders as viewed within the context of the DSM-IV Text Revisions published in 2000 and review the expected changes for DSM-5.
- Acquire familiarity with the major current diagnostic categories and the criteria for proper diagnostic assessments and evaluations.
